Scales	<p style="text-align: center;">Circle up</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Model the activity</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sing up the scale 1 1,2,1 1,2,3,2,1 1, 2, 3, 4, 3, 2, 1</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Complete the scale up and down</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Replace a number with a sound and another number with a sound.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">E.g. 2 = bleh and 5 = boo!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Repeat the exercise.</p> <p style="text-align: center; color: red;">Focus on the noise or the new sound and focus on getting that in the right place. That is the unusual bit and the game of the scene. That's the bit that will be funniest.</p>	All	5 minutes
Sing your name	<p style="text-align: center;">Sing your name</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fit your name to the tune. Sing only those words in individual syllables. The name may begin or end in the middle. Two Penises	<p style="text-align: center;">An introduction to rhyming.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The whole group creates a rhythm.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Two penises, two penises</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>What would you do with two penises?</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person A: <i>The first one I would hold real tight</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person B: <i>The second one I'd sleep with at night.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center; color: red;">The focus here is on Person A to set up an appropriate rhyme for the next player. Try and use an idea that has an obvious rhyme.</p>	All	15 minutes
8 things (or fewer depending)	<p style="text-align: center;">Person A: Hi ____!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person B: Hi ____!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person A: Can you tell me 8 things with legs?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person B then sings one idea at a time the rest of the people on stage follow the idea with "1 thing, 2 things" each time.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">E.g. Person B "Humans" (Response: "1 thing!")</p> <p style="text-align: center;">"Caterpillars (Response: "2 things"</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Complete all the way up to 8 things</p> <p style="text-align: center; color: red;">It doesn't matter what you say. The wrong thing is going to be funny too! So just commit and really go for it. Own your "bad" choice and make it the game of the scene.</p>	Groups of 5	15 minutes
A Chorus about your day	<p style="text-align: center;">The first player in the line tells a brief story from their day. 4 or 5 sentences.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The next person in the line sings a chorus about that person's day using 4 lines.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person A: I went to the shop to buy some vegetables for a curry I'm cooking for my friends tomorrow night at games night.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Person B: "Catering for friends</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Catering for friends</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The fun it never ends</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Catering for friends" (Or whatever the chorus is!)</p> <p style="text-align: center; color: red;">You do not need to try and find a rhyme - 4 of the same line is absolutely fine!</p>	Groups of 5	20 minutes

<p>Cell Block Tango</p>	<p>The performance piece!</p> <p>Set 4 chairs. 1 person on each chair and one person in the middle.</p> <p>Take a suggestion of a theme E.G. "Swimming"</p> <p>Each person on the chair associates a word with the theme - a method of murder.</p> <p>A: Float</p> <p>B: Armband</p> <p>C: Chlorine</p> <p>D: Diving Board</p> <p>(Repeat down the line to the beat)</p> <p>The fifth person sings the chorus.</p> <p>"Death in the swimming pool,  Death in the swimming pool,  Death in the swimming pool,</p> <p>Swim and it's your life you'll lose (Or whatever the chorus is!)</p> <p>Then Person A delivers a monologue - about how they ended up in the prison.
